
HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT WORKS PROGRESS AND FLIGHT CHECK OF CENTRE RUNWAY (07C/25C) UNDER RECONFIGURATION

1 Introduction


- 1.1 The Centre Runway (07C/25C) and its associated taxiways have been temporarily closed for reconfiguration works since July 2022. The reconfiguration works are still on-going and are expected to be completed within 2024.
- 1.2 The aerodrome environment in the vicinity of the closed Centre Runway (07C/25C) will be changed as part of the next phase of reconfiguration works from 31 July 2024 onwards. In addition, flight check for the Centre Runway (07C/25C) is tentatively scheduled from 4 August 2024 to 11 September 2024. This AIP Supplement serves to notify airport users of these forthcoming changes and arrangements.
- 2 Changes to Aerodrome Environment in the vicinity of the Closed Centre Runway (07C/25C)
- 2.1 The location of the closed Centre Runway (07C/25C) under reconfiguration, in relation to the two operating runways, i.e. the South Runway (07R/25L) and the North Runway (07L/25R), is depicted in Attachment A.
- 2.2 Starting from 31 July 2024, the security fence separating the closed Centre Runway (07C/25C) and associated taxiways from the operational area will be progressively replaced by marker boards. Airport users will thus have a clearer view of the non-operational areas still under construction (i.e. the hatched areas as shown in Attachment B). Despite these changes to the aerodrome environment, attention of airport users should be drawn that the enclosed area remains non-operational and that the Centre Runway (07C/25C) and associated taxiways are still NOT open for aircraft operations.
- 2.3 White closed runway markings have been displayed on the pavement surface at intervals along the entire length of the runway and a flashing white-lighted cross has also been placed at each end of the closed Centre Runway (07C/25C). In addition, yellow closed taxiway markings will be displayed at each junction of the new taxiways under construction which have interface with the existing operational area, as depicted in Attachment B.
- 2.4 Runway holding position markings and mandatory instruction markings for Centre Runway (07C/25C) will be painted on the entry and exit points to the runway on Taxiway T and Taxiway B6 as a visual alert to airport users. While the Centre Runway (07C/25C) remains non-operational (except during the flight check period mentioned in Paragraph 3 below, where it will be used by the flight check aircraft only), airport users shall closely follow ATC instructions and are reminded to be vigilant when crossing the Centre Runway (07C/25C).
- 3 Temporary Arrangement during Flight Check of the Centre Runway (07C/25C)
- 3.1 In preparation for the commissioning of Centre Runway (07C/25C), flight check will be conducted daily from 2200 UTC to 0200 UTC between 4 August 2024 and 11 September 2024 tentatively.
- To facilitate the safe conduct of flight check, the flashing white-lighted crosses, closed runway markings, closed taxiway markings and marker boards within the runway strip of the Centre Runway (07C/25C) will be temporarily removed before the flight check and be reinstated after the completion of flight check daily during this period (Attachment C). Airport users are reminded that despite such temporary arrangement, the Centre Runway (07C/25C) and associated taxiways are still NOT open for aircraft operations.
- During flight check operations, arrival aircraft from the North Runway (07L/25R) may be held on Taxiway E or Taxiway F before being cleared to cross the Centre Runway (07C/25C). Airport users shall closely follow ATC instructions and are reminded to be vigilant when crossing the Centre Runway (07C/25C).
